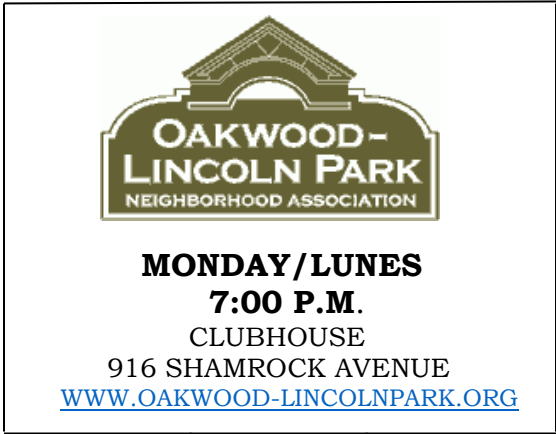

RECODE is well under way. The third and possibly final draft came out in mid-October. There are some misconceptions about Recode. One is that duplexes will “no longer be allowed” in proposed RN2 zoning. The current zoning allows for duplexes with “use on review” and the proposed zoning allows for duplexes with “special use approval.”

Thanks to neighbors that commented, the Infill Housing Design Guidelines will be maintained. However, continuing pressure to zone our area for multi-family housing increases demolition risk for our single-family housing developed a century ago.
