Oakwood Design Overlay

In 2016, a resolution was approved by City Council to enhance the current infill design overlay for a portion of Oakwood. The streets included in the resolution were those between Central & Harvey from Morelia to Oldham. A small section of Oak Hill has been added due the number of original homes near the former St. Mary's site.

A committee was formed after the last public meeting to recommend the best way to protect this area. Both NC1 and H1 overlays were considered. The committee is recommending an H1 overlay based on the volume of renovations which are not covered by NC1 or infill. Full details of the overlay guidelines can be found on the Knox Planning Website. A public meeting will be held on September 17th, 2019.
